Art--Foundation

101 ***Contemporary Issues in Art*** Credit: 2 hours.

Exposes the first year student in an interactive lecture/discussion format to contemporary issues in the visual arts. Course requirements include attendance of course lectures, field trips, visiting artist presentations, keeping of a journal and the writing of a paper.

102 ***Drawing, I*** Credit: 3 hours.

Theory and practice in the elements of drawing. This course is open to Art and Design majors only.

103 ***Design, I*** Credit: 3 hours.

Theory and practice in the elements of two dimensional design and the study of color. This course is open to Art and Design Majors only.

104 ***Drawing, II*** Credit: 3 hours.

Continuation of ARTF 102. Theory and practice in the elements of drawing. This course is open to Art and Design majors only. Prerequisite: ARTF 102.

105 ***Design, II*** Credit: 3 hours.

Theory and practice in the elements of three dimensional design. This course is open to Art and Design majors only. Prerequisite: ARTF 103.

199 ***Undergraduate Open Seminar*** Credit: 1 to 5 hours.
