Czech

101 ***Elementary Czech I*** credit: 4 hours.

Develops basic proficiency in Czech in listening, speaking, reading, and writing.

102 ***Elementary Czech II*** credit: 4 hours.

Continuation of CZCH 101. Prerequisite: CZCH 101.

199 ***Undergraduate Open Seminar*** credit: 1 to 5 hours.

May be repeated.

201 ***Second-year Czech I*** credit: 4 hours.

Develops intermediate-level proficiency in Czech in listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Prerequisite: CZCH 102 or equivalent.

202 ***Second-year Czech II*** credit: 4 hours.

Continuation of CZCH 201. Prerequisite: CZCH 201 or equivalent.

483 ***The Structure of Modern Czech*** credit: 3 hours.

Analysis of the sound system and grammar of the contemporary Czech language with some reference to its historical development. Prerequisite: Knowledge of another Slavic language, preferably Russian, or consent of instructor.

484 ***Readings in Czech*** credit: 3 or 4 hours.

Reading and analysis of selected texts. 3 undergraduate hours. 4 graduate hours. Prerequisite: CZCH 202, CZCH 483 or consent of instructor.
