Case studies are used to examine Air Force leadership and management situations as a means of demonstrating and exercising practical application of the concepts. Requires concurrent enrollment with AFAS 102. Prerequisite: AFAS 222 or consent of instructor.

S. national security policy. In addition, students study leadership and management, ethical decision making, and communication skills. Requires concurrent enrollment with AFAS 102. Prerequisite: AFAS 332 or consent of instructor.
