Within this framework, five significant periods are covered: (1) western incursion into East Asia and its impact; (2) Japan's response to western incursion and how it impacted Korea; (3) US and Soviet occupation of Korea and how it contributed to its permanent division; (4) Cold War relationship in East Asia; and (5) the post Cold War.

By discussing the narrative and rhetorical styles of four major accounts dealing with issues such as wars, family tensions and person tribulations at a given historical time, students will understand how Koreans have dealt with conflict throughout history. This course will emphasize not only the conflict in the historical events portrayed by the accounts, but the inner conflict of the authors in their narratives. Readings will be in English.
