

# Course Schedule - Spring 2008

## English as a Second Language

114 ***Intro to Academic Writing*** credit: 3 hours.

Review of the fundamentals of paragraph writing and introduction to the multi-paragraph essay; instruction on basics of library research. The ESL 114/ESL 115 sequence fulfills the campus Composition I requirement for non-native speakers of English. Prerequisite: ESL 113 or recommendation from UIUC English as a Second Language Placement Test.

This course satisfies the General Education Criteria for a Freshman Composition I course.

Proof of eligibility must be brought to the first meeting of the class. No student will be permitted to remain in the class who does not take the Diagnostic Test administered during the first three class meetings.
